

Colorado State Block

***STATE IMAGE NEEDS TO BE REVERSED FOR RAW EDGE APPLIQUE**

Supplies:

1 - 6 ½" Square WHITE Background fabric

1 - 6 ½" square of lightweight fusible interfacing

Optional - 4 pc Laser cut applique shapes

OR

1 - 7" square of blue for the the mountain range and forest

1 - 3" square of Yellow/orange for the sun (sun should measure approx. 1 ½")

1 - 4" square of Red/orange for the C (C should measure approx. 3")

Fuse the interfacing to the WRONG side of the white background square.

Trace the applique images onto the paper side of paper backed fusible (such as Heat & Bond Lite)

Trace 1 of each shape (reverse them for raw edge applique)

Rough cut out the appliques.

Press the traced appliques onto the WRONG sides of the chosen fabrics.

Cut out the appliques on the drawn lines.

Fuse the applique shapes to the RIGHT side of the background square. Line up the forest with the bottom of the background square, line the mountains up with the top of the background square. Place the C first then the sun circle.

Stitch the mountain and forest appliques down with a small straight stitch inside the appliques about an ¼" inside of the raw edge. Use a small zig zag or blanket stitch to stitch down the C and sun appliques.
